

FACTS	What does Prio Wealth LP ("Prio") do with your personal information?
WHY?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
WHAT?	<ul> <li>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</li> <li>Social Security number, date of birth and address</li> <li>Assets, liabilities, income and expenses</li> <li>Personal financial statements and tax returns</li> <li>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</li> </ul>
HOW?	All financial companies need to share a customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list reasons financial companies can share their customer's personal information; the reasons Prio chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do				
How does Prio protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards, secured files and buildings as well as monitoring the secure measures of our third- party vendors who support our business.			
How does Prio collect my personal information?	<ul> <li>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</li> <li>Open an account or give us your personal information</li> <li>Tell us about your investment or retirement portfolios</li> <li>Enter into an investment advisory contract</li> <li>Give us other personal information</li> <li>Show your government-issued ID</li> <li>We also collect your personal information from other institutions such as custodians, banks, attorneys, accountants and/or other advisors.</li> </ul>			
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<ul> <li>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</li> <li>sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes- information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>affiliates from using your information to market toyou</li> <li>sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> <li>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing</li> </ul>			

Definitions			
Affiliates	<ul><li>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li><li>Prio may share nonpublic personal information with its subsidiary, Seaward Fiduciary Trust Services, as applicable</li></ul>		
Non-affiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Non-affiliates that we share with can include companies that aggregate data for administrative and reporting purposes.</li> </ul>		
Joint Marketing	<ul> <li>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</li> <li>Prio does not jointly market.</li> </ul>
